- **Art Auction:** Students create and donate artwork to be auctioned off to parents, teachers, and community members.
- Craft Fair: Host a fair where students can sell handmade crafts, jewelry, and other creations.
- **Photography Contest:** Hold a photography contest and sell prints or calendars featuring the best submissions.
- Bake Sale: Students can bake and sell treats during lunch breaks or school events.
- **Spirit Week:** Organize themed dress-up days and charge a small fee for participation.
- Talent Show: Host a talent show and sell tickets to students, families, and community members.
- Fun Run/Walk-a-Thon: Organize a sponsored run or walk where students gather pledges for each mile or lap completed.
- Sports Tournament: Arrange a basketball, soccer, or volleyball tournament with an entry fee for teams.
- Car Wash: Students can set up a car wash station and offer their services for donations.
- Yard Sale: Collect gently used items from the community and hold a large yard sale.
- **Recycling Drive:** Organize a drive to collect recyclable items and exchange them for money at a recycling center.
- Movie Night: Host a movie night at the school or community center and sell tickets and concessions.
- Game Night: Organize a board game or video game tournament with an entry fee.
- **Restaurant Partnership:** Partner with a local restaurant to donate a percentage of sales from a particular night to your cause.
- Food Truck Festival: Invite local food trucks to set up at the school and donate a portion of their sales.
- **Custom Merchandise:** Design and sell t-shirts, hoodies, or other merchandise with school logos or custom designs.
- Coupon Books: Sell coupon books with discounts from local businesses.
- Greeting Cards: Create and sell handmade greeting cards for various occasions.
- Pet Parade: Organize a pet parade where participants pay an entry fee to show off their pets.
- **Workshops:** Host workshops on various topics like arts and crafts, coding, or cooking, and charge a participation fee.
- Coin Drive: Collect spare change from classmates and the community over a set period.
- Bike-a-Thon: Kids can participate in a bike ride and collect donations based on the distance they ride.
- Obstacle Course: Set up a fun obstacle course and charge an entry fee for participation.
- Scavenger Hunt: Organize a scavenger hunt and charge a participation fee. Offer small prizes for winners.
- Lemonade Stand: Kids can set up a lemonade stand in the neighborhood or at a school event.
- Popcorn/Candy Bar Sale: Sell popcorn and/or candy bars at school events, sports games, or during recess.
- Ice Cream Social: Host an ice cream social where kids can sell ice cream and toppings.
- Pet Wash: Set up a pet wash station where kids can wash neighborhood pets for donations.
- Toy Sale: Have kids collect gently used toys and hold a toy sale.
- **Read-a-Thon:** Kids gather pledges for the number of books or pages they read over a certain period.
- Lego Building Contest: Organize a Lego building contest and charge a participation fee.
- **Pumpkin Decorating Contest:** In the fall, kids can decorate pumpkins and charge an entry fee for the contest.
- Holiday Gift Wrapping: Offer a gift-wrapping service during the holiday season for donations.
- **Flamingo Flocking:** Purchase plastic flamingos (lawn decorations). Attach cards to the flamingoes' necks with a phone number along with all the information regarding your group. State that for a donation, the flamingos will be removed.
